Description: Share your love of nature and help protect Florida's environment! Learn more about different habitats flora and fauna while you help in many activities around our beautiful Preserve!

Activities may include:

- ◆ Monthly cleanup and trim of the Florida Yards and Neighborhood native plant demonstration garden.
- ◆ Help with annual native plant sale.
- ◆ Group or independent trail clearing and trail maintenance may include use of approved herbicide.
- ◆ Assist or lead exotic plant removal and restoration days scheduled 1-2 days per year.
- ◆ Patrol of preserve properties including the Eagle, Firefly, Owa-Hee, Hog Hammock Trails and Apoxee Park areas. Monitor general condition along trail may remove trash, prune and trim brush.
- ◆ May monitor preserve areas to determine plant and wildlife activities

Required: Must be familiar with native and exotic plants and able to distinguish between the two.

You must be physically fit and able to do occasional strenuous activities such as hiking in the swamp, digging, chopping and gardening. Minimum of one shift per month required.
