The City Commission of the City of West Palm Beach met in special session on Thursday, July 10, 2008 at 2:52 p.m., at City Hall, with the following persons present:

Mayor Lois J. Frankel, President of the Commission Geraldine Muoio, Commissioner Molly Douglas, Commissioner William Moss, Commissioner Isaac Robinson, Jr., City Administrator Edward Mitchell, City Attorney Claudia McKenna and City Clerk Blane Kauthen.

INVOCATION / PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

The Mayor offered a moment of silence in honor of all the men and women serving overseas and Commissioner Muoio led the Pledge of Allegiance.

CONSENT CALENDAR:

It was moved by Commissioner Moss, seconded by Commissioner Muoio, to approve the following Consent Calendar:

and thereafter it was voted as follows: Ayes: Commissioners Douglas, Moss, Muoio and Robinson. Motion therefore carried unanimously.

Swearing in of newly elected City Commissioner for District Three (3) – City Clerk Blane Kauthen administered the Oath of Office for the District 3 Commission seat to Kimberly Mitchell. Commissioner Mitchell [a] commended those present for their dedication to the City; [b] stated that she is grateful to be re-elected; [c] showed appreciation for Colonel Alan West’s service to the United States; [d] thanked 15th Judicial Circuit of Florida Judge Diana Louis and Palm Beach County Commissioner Robert Kanjian for their presence; and [e] introduced Madison McIntosh, who sang the “Star Spangled Banner”.
